### Parichay

### **Best ISP Study Groups**

ISP Study groups all over have been involved in conducting various activities throughout the year. Reports of the study groups will be evaluated by the Awards committee and the Best ISP Study Group will be awarded at the Inaugural Ceremony of the 43<sup>rd</sup> National Conference of ISP.

### **Journal of Indian Society of Periodontology**

On 15<sup>th</sup> September 2017, Dr. Ashish Kumar was given the responsibility of the journal which was in backlog or a period of over one year. He started working on the journal and saw to it that it was on time since Jan Feb 2018. When he had taken over in September 2017, by February 2018, he had taken out eight issues of JISP and brought it on time. He improved on the communications from the Editors side to every author on submission of any manuscript, as earlier there was no communication from the Editor on submission and the article was kept in editorial review for almost about six months to one year. He as an editor has cut down the response time to almost a week and the article is sent for review within a week's time. With this efficient manuscript management, the journal has crossed the maximum number of articles submitted till second week of August 2018 and had a submission of 521 articles and there are still a couple of months left in this calendar year. He is

also trying for release of JISP on 1<sup>st</sup> day of every month, and from September the issue will come on 3<sup>rd</sup> Sept while after that every alternate month 1<sup>st</sup> day will see the release of the issue of JISP. From the time he has taken over as Editor, he has cleared 731 manuscripts and there were no articles which are pending with the Editor.

The office is hopeful that with such a kind of regularity JISP will have more advertisers coming in for advertisements in times to come and along with the business manager the journal self-sufficient once again.
