### **Agenda a: Meeting call to order by President**

The Presidential Collar was adorned on to the President, Dr. Pravin Kudva, who greeted and welcomed the members for the Annual General Body Meeting. The President called the meeting to order.

### **Agenda b: Presidential address by the President/Chairman**

The President Dr. Pravin Kudva expressed satisfaction over the activities conducted by the ISP in the past one year. He appealed to the members of the society to discuss all issues which were being faced by the society in a civilised manner and take decisions by consensus in the best interest of the society and the profession. He congratulated the secretary Dr. Balaji Manohar for all the cooperation extended during his tenure as the President and appreciated the work done by the office over the past few years. He requested the Secretary Dr. Balaji Manohar to proceed with the meeting.

Dr. Balaji Manohar requested the house to observe two minutes silence as a mark of respect to Dr. S. A. Kale, Dr. J. K. Gupta and Dr. Satyendra Singh who went for the heavenly abode in the recent past. So, a two minutes

silence was observed to pay homage to the departed souls.

### **Agenda c: Any other motion for change in the order of business.**

There was no change in the order of the business.

### **Agenda d: Confirmation of the minutes of the previous Annual General Body Meeting/ Extra Ordinary General Body Meeting, if any.**

The minutes of the AGM held at Hyderabad on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2015 were circulated to the members. There were no corrections received by the office. 4th EC meeting were considered. The minutes were passed proposed by Dr. Nitin Dani and seconded by Dr. Neeraj Deshpande.

### **Agenda e: Adoption of the Annual report of the Head Office, Scientific Programme Convenor, Periodontal Health Care Convenor and the Journal office for the year.**

The secretary informed that the annual report was circulated to the members, but added that there was no mention of the Life Time Achievement Awards ceremony which were conferred on the founder members of the ISP at the 40<sup>th</sup> National Conference held at Hyderabad. So, the same will be mentioned in the Annual report for the year 2016. He said

that the report included the Scientific programme activities, the Periodontal health care activities and the Journal details and were read during the Secretary's report at the Inaugural ceremony of the conference. He said that the same can be passed. The report from the Head office was proposed by Dr. Dilip Pol and seconded by Dr. Biju Thomas.

**Agenda f: Adoption of the Annual report of the Treasurer and audited statement of the accounts of the previous year ending on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016.**

The Treasurer Dr Anil M apprised the house that the office was facing a lot of difficulties in preparing the accounts and filing of the Income Tax returns. The IT returns were not filed since 1996 and the CA has prepared the balance sheet and the details of tax liability was already discussed. Now since the things are ready, in the near future the entire amount of IT will be paid by the society. Secretary Dr. Balaji Manohar said that this issue was discussed at the AGM in Jaipur and the members were of the opinion that all the tax matters of the society should be clear so that we do not have to pay any penalty hence onwards. He informed that the matter was discussed in the EOGM also and it was decided to avail the voluntary income disclosure scheme of the IT department for our society as was suggested by the CA. accordingly the total income disclosed was 1.42 crores during the said period and the net payable amount in the income disclosure scheme is Rupees fifty four lakhs. He added that the balance sheet for the year 2014 – 15 has also been prepared and the tax liability will be taken care of by the office. He said that this is the only option left with the society and the CA has advised that henceforth all the programmes need to be organised in a systematic manner and the accounting of each and every programme be done properly. He then sought approval from the house for the payment of pending dues of the IT department. It was

unanimously resolved to go ahead with the requirements with regards to the filing of income tax. Dr. Balaji suggested to formulate guidelines for all the programmes including the main Conference, PG Convention and other activities so that the organisers can be informed about the same well in advance and the proper accounting can be done.

Dr. Manish Khatri suggested that the ISP should also go in to obtain income tax exemption as per IT section 80 G and 12 AA which will help us in reducing the tax liability in future. Dr. Balaji said that the office was in the process of doing the same and hopefully we will be able to do it. He said that 12 AA can be obtained if we have filed the IT returns for the past three years and which will be done once we file the IT returns for the year 2015 – 16.

**Agenda g: Election of new Office bearers and Executive committee members.**

Dr. Pravin Kudva said that a lot of deliberations have taken place regarding the elections of the office bearers and there were also a lot of difference of opinion on the issue. For the past two months since the 3<sup>rd</sup> EC meeting at MAHE the issue was going on and the EC members who met on Friday during the EC meeting and even today morning i.e. Saturday unanimously in the best interest of the ISP have come up with a proposal, which needs to be accepted by the house so that all the differences are sorted out and everything settles down amicably. He requested all the members of the society to cooperate in implementing this decision. He requested Dr. Santosh Sreedhar to elaborate on the new office bearers and EC members. Dr. Santosh Sreedhar informed that the decision to unanimously propose the following names was taken in the greater interest of the society.

There were 3 vacancies left in the New EC members category. There were 19 names suggested from the house and so it was decided to go in for lucky draw with chits. The names selected were Drs Vikas Jindal, Vivek Govila and Vikas Dev.

The President Dr. Pravin Kudva once again read the names of the new Office Bearers and EC members and congratulated them.

**Agenda h: Appointment of an Auditor.**

Dr. Balaji Manohar said that the new auditor will be appointed by the new office and so the appointment can be done in the 1<sup>st</sup> EC meeting of the ensuing year.

**Agenda i: Resolution brought forward by the Executive Committee.**

The first resolution put forth by the EC was to prepone the allotment of National Post Graduate Convention as there is very less time for the organisers of the event for preparations and getting sponsors. Dr. Balaji Manohar informed that the allotment of the National Post Graduate Convention was allotted in the month of October during the AGM and the same is organised after 4 to 5 months on being allotted. The matter was discussed extensively at the 2<sup>nd</sup> EC meeting and it was resolved to allot the National Post Graduate Convention well in advance may be year or so. Dr. Ashish Jain opined that it has been mentioned in the ISP constitution, but there is ambiguity in the same. So, it has to be passed in the AGM. It was decided to work out the advance time frame for the allotment of the PG Convention in the EC meeting.

The second resolution brought forward by the EC was the registration charges for the next 3 National Conferences i.e. from 2017 to 2019 will be the same as the ISP Nagpur Conference. And after wards there will be a 10% increase in the registration fees for 2020 National

Conference, and the same amount will be charged for National Conferences held in 2020 to 2022.

There was a lot of discussions on this issue with inputs from members. Dr. Ashish Jain said that going by the records there is no utilisation of the journal fund which has been collected over the past few years and so there is no point in taxing the general members for paying the 10% of the Journal fund in the conference registration fees. Instead the amount can be reduced from the registration fees or we can introduce the delegate only fees for the conference following Kolkata. Dr Santosh Sreedhar said that the 10% clause is there in the constitution and hence cannot be done away with. However, we can have these suggestions be incorporated in the constitutional amendments which are an ongoing process. The president Dr. Pravin Kudva said that we will go as per the guidelines framed in the Constitution committee.

The third resolution put forth was the allotment of 16<sup>th</sup> National PG Convention to Manali as it is the only bid received by the office.

The house approved the above resolutions.

**Agenda j: Any other business with the permission of the chair.**

- a) **41<sup>st</sup> National Conference of ISP, Nagpur.** Dr Abhay Kolte informed about the programmes conducted till then. He said that the scientific programme was going on as per schedule and there was a positive feedback from most of the delegates. The Banquet is scheduled at the empress palace which is about 10 kms from the venue. Buses have been arranged for the delegates and it was requested on behalf of the organising

committee that all the delegates should reach the venue on time. Proper arrangements have been made throughout the conference and in case of any problem to anybody they can get in touch with any of the organisers. He added that a special Orange Lounge has been put in place at the conference venue for both the days and delegates are being served with oranges free of cost. They can even take a few with them and carry bags will be provided at the lounge for the same. The lounge also has provisions of free tea and coffee arrangements.

- b) **42<sup>nd</sup> National Conference of ISP, Kolkata.** Dr. Abhijit Chakraborty welcomed all the members to Kolkata Conference and requested enthusiastic participation. The conference dates finalised were 24<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> November 2017. He said that a registration desk has been arranged at the conference venue and he appealed to all the members to register as early as possible. He assured a great scientific treat and hospitality at Kolkata.
- c) **16<sup>th</sup> National PG Convention of ISP, Manali.** Dr. Vikas Jindal thanked the house for allotting the National PG Convention at Manali. He assured the best possible arrangements and hospitality at Manali. He informed the modes of reaching Manali and requested support and cooperation of all in making the Convention a grand success.

He congratulated the new Office Bearers and the EC members and hoped that they will be working more zeal so as to meet the expectations on the professional front. He further assured to continue working for the society as and when needed.
