RULES & REGULATION FOR ISP ESSAY COMPETITION 2019

1. Competition is open to all Dental Surgeons and students as per the specified categories.
2. Only one entry per person is allowed. An essay may be written by not more than two authors, each of whom must be of the same category.
3. All the entries must be submitted in triplicate & one soft copy in CD.
4. Length of essay should be within 1750 to 1800 words. Number of words should be strictly adhered to. Essays larger than the prescribed words will not be considered for prizes.
5. Entry must be typed on one side of the A4 size paper in double spacing and may be accompanied by illustrations, tables, sketches, photographs etc. If necessary appropriate legends should be sent.
6. Name, address, contact mobile number and e-mail id of the participant must be typed on a separate sheet sent along with the entry. It should not appear anywhere in the text of the essay.
7. One winner will be selected for each prize in each category. If the essay is written by more than one author the prize money will be equally shared amongst them.
8. The entries should not have been published or sent for publication anywhere else.
9. Entries once submitted will not be returned.
10. Indian Society of Periodontology reserves the rights of publication.
11. The decision of the jury will be final and no correspondence in this matter will be entertained.
12. Entries submitted by the Under Graduate, Interns and Post Graduate Dental Students of Other Specialities have to be accompanied by a certificate from the Principal / Head of Department of concerned college testifying the status of the competitor.
13. Dental Surgeons should enclose a copy of their degree certificate.
14. Participant in category II should be Associate members of ISP and should mention their ISP Membership Number.
15. Participant in Category IV should be a life member of the Indian Society of Periodontology and should mention their ISP Membership number.
16. All entries should be submitted personally or by Courier/Regd. Post to the Convener - Essay Competition at the address mentioned.
17. Authors should send an undertaking that contents have not been copied unauthorizedly.
