Agenda a: Meeting call to order by President

The Presidential Collar was adorned on to the President, Dr. Nitin Dani, who greeted and welcomed the members for the Annual General Body Meeting. The President called the meeting to order.

Agenda b: Presidential address by the President/Chairman

The President Dr. Nitin Dani expressed satisfaction over the activities conducted by the ISP in the past one year. He congratulated the Secretary Dr. Abhay Kolte for all the cooperation extended during his tenure as the President and appreciated the work done by the office especially when some decisions were required to be taken for the benefit of the society. He requested the Secretary Dr. Abhay Kolte to proceed with the meeting.

Dr. Abhay Kolte requested all the Associate Members present in the hall to leave, as the meeting was only for the Life Members of the society.

Agenda c: Any other motion for change in the order of business.

There was no change in the order of the business.

Agenda d: Confirmation of the minutes of the previous Annual General Body Meeting/ Extra Ordinary General Body Meeting, if any.

The minutes of the AGM held at Kolkata on Saturday, 25th November 2017, 12.30 pm at the Main Hall, Hotel J. W. Marriot, Kolkata were circulated to the members. There were no corrections received by the office. The minutes were passed

Agenda e: Adoption of the Annual report of the Head Office, Scientific Programme Convenor, Periodontal Health Care Convenor and the Journal office for the year.

The Secretary informed that the Annual Report was circulated to the members which included the Scientific programme activities, the Periodontal health care activities and the Journal details and were read during the Secretary's report at the Inaugural ceremony of the conference. He said that since there were no corrections received by the office, the same can be passed. The report from the Head office was

Agenda f: Adoption of the Annual report of the Treasurer and audited statement of the accounts of the previous year ending on 31st March 2018.

(Adoption of the Annual report of the Treasurer and Audited statement of the accounts of the previous years ending on 31st March 2017 and 2018 and Income and Expenditure account from 1st April 2016 – 31st March 2017 and 1st April 2017-31st March 2018).

Dr. Abhay Kolte said that the accounts of the society for the year 2016-17 and 2017-18 have been placed on the table so that all the members can go through the copies of the same. He admitted that though there was a delay in preparation of the accounts but it was a huge task which was done with great difficulty as many things of the year 2016-17 were required to be clarified from the previous office. He appealed to all the members to go through them and informed that the accounts were circulated to all the EC members and have been passed by the EC. If there are any clarifications required from any member the same can be discussed in the meeting and the accounts can be passed. Regarding 80 G and 12 AA Certificate the IT returns of the society needs to be regular for a period of three consecutive years. After that we will be able to apply for obtaining Income tax exemption as per IT section 80 G and 12 AA which will help us in reducing the tax liability in future.

Dr. Nitin Dani congratulated the elected members and once again read the names of the new Office Bearers and EC members.

Agenda h: Appointment of an Auditor.

Dr. Abhay Kolte said that M/S Ruchi Yash Verma & Associates were entrusted with the work of official auditors of the society this year and if the house approves, we will continue with the same auditor in the forthcoming year 2018-2019. The house approved the same.

Agenda i: Resolution Brought Forward by the Executive Committee.

Dr. Abhay Kolte informed the house that after deliberating in the EC Meetings in the past year it was decided to bring these resolutions in the AGM so that they can be passed. The following resolutions have been proposed,

- 1) The 18th ISP National PG Convention is being allotted to Jaipur as per the decision of the 4th EC Meeting held at Chandigarh on 5th October 2018.
- 2) The 44th National Conference of ISP is being allotted to Bangalore as per the decision of the 4th EC Meeting held at Chandigarh on 5th October 2018.
- 3) As per the decision taken in the 4th EC Meeting at held Chandigarh on 5th October 2018, the COC of the 42nd National Conference of ISP will have to deposit the Journal Fund with the ISP Head Office immediately failing which further action will be initiated against them as per the constitutional provisions.

The house approved the above resolutions.

Agenda j: Any other business with the permission of the chair.

- a) **43rd National Conference of ISP, Chandigarh.** Dr Baljeet Singh thanked the delegates for making the event a grand success. He briefed the members about the conference and hoped that everyone enjoyed their stay at Chandigarh. He said that the entire COC needs to be appreciated for their valuable inputs and the work they have been doing since the past few months. He also thanked the ISP Head Office and the EC for giving him and his team the opportunity to host the conference. He added that after the completion of all the formalities he will submit the accounts within the stipulated time frame.
- b) **17th National PG Convention of ISP, Chennai.** Dr. Selvakumar said that the Journal fund from the ISP PG

Convention, Chennai were submitted to the office. He enquired regarding the balance amount of Rs. 47,400/- out of which an amount of Rs. 10,000/- is to be paid to one of the vendors. It was informed that the balance amount of Rs. 37,400/- has to be deposited with the ISP Head Office as the PG Convention profit.

- c) **44th National Conference of ISP, Bangalore.** Dr. Anirban Chatterjee thanked the ISP Head Office and the EC for allotting the 44th National Conference of ISP to Bangalore. The proposed dates were 8th to 10th November 2019. The preconference courses will be on 8th November 2019. The COC comprises of Dr A. R. Pradeep as the Conference Secretary, Dr. V. Ranganath – Organising Chairman, Dr. Anirban Chatterjee – Organising Secretary, Dr. Mahantesh – Treasurer, and Dr. Ashish Nichani – Scientific Chairman. He said that they had shortlisted three venues MANPHO Centre, Hotel Sheraton Grand (Inhouse) and Palace ground for the conference and will finalise one of them within a month. They have got the PAN card in the name of the conference and have opened a bank account in Axis Bank. The registration fees remain unchanged at Rs. 8000/- plus GST for Associate members and Rs. 8500/- plus GST for Life members and Accompanying person Rs. 7500/- plus GST till 7th March 2019 as Early bird. He informed that the conference website www.ispconferencebangalore.com will be functional within a week and people can start with the online registrations. The entire programme details will be informed at the 2nd EC Meeting.

18th National PG Convention of ISP, Jaipur. Dr. Pravin Kudva thanked the ISP Head Office and the EC for allotting the PG Convention at Jaipur and appealed to all the members to come to Jaipur for the 18th National PG Convention of ISP “Perio – Preksha”. He said that the theme of the Convention was “Experiment, Innovate and Excel”. The dates of the PG Convention are 19th to 21st April 2019. The preconference courses will be on the Friday, 19th April 2019. The venue was finalised and it will be Birla Auditorium where the previous National Conference of ISP was conducted. The preconference courses will be held at the Jaipur Dental College and may be a couple of other colleges as well. The registration fees have been unchanged from the previous ISP PG Convention, Chennai and is Rs. 4000/- plus GST for Associate members and Rs. 5000/- plus GST for Life members till 31st January 2019. He said that the organising committee is the same as the National Conference of Jaipur with Dr. Pravin Kudva as the Organising Chairman, Dr. Monica Rao – Organising Secretary, Dr. Rohini Gaba – Treasurer and Dr. Geeta Bhat – Scientific Chairperson. The scientific programme will cover all the important topics for the PG students. The details of the scientific programme are being chalked out and will be announced shortly through the website. The website is almost ready and is www.isppgconvention2019.com. The bank account has been opened and PAN also procured. Within a couple of days, the GST number will also be allotted.

Agenda k: Presidents Concluding Remarks.

The President Dr. Nitin Dani thanked all the members of the Organising Committee of the 43rd National Conference of ISP especially Dr. Ashish Jain, Dr. Nympha Pandit, Dr. Baljeet Singh and the entire team for the excellent organisation and hospitality. He also thanked all the members of the ISP for giving him a chance to serve the society as its President. He appreciated the cooperation extended by Secretary Dr. Abhay Kolte who managed the things systematically and in a proper way. He thanked the members and the EC in conducting various activities the whole year round. He said that the time to time guidance provided by the Past Presidents and senior members of the society was invaluable and enabled him to take decisions on numerous occasions. He congratulated Dr. Anil Melath who would be taking over from him as the President of this prestigious society and appealed to all the members to extend the same cooperation to the new team. He appealed to all the members to work with renewed zeal towards meeting the expectations of the members and the society. He further assured to continue working for the society as and when needed.
